## European Commission projects

### **iSERV**

The iSERV project project is nearing its halfway stage and achieved important results during the first 18 months of its implementation. The on-line database is undergoing its final tests before being released for end users to access. iSERV aims at collecting sub-hourly HVAC system energy use data from around 1600 HVAC systems in the EU Member States and analyse this information helping HVAC systems achieve up to 35 - 40% energy savings.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> issue of the iSERV newsletter was just released providing more details about the recent activities. It focusses on the contributions of the Project's Industry Steering Group and other stakeholders interested in the energy use of HVAC systems and highlights the last iSERV workshops, among others the seminar organized during REHVA Annual Meeting in Timisoara. The newsletter also provides hyperlink access to the project website inviting interested parties to register in the website and learn more about the 'in-use' benchmarking of HVAC systems or being part of the iSERV automatic monitoring and feedback system.
